1. Rules and Organising Authority.

This regatta is organised by the Sussex Inlet & Basin Yacht Club Inc governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of World Sailing the prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, the Australian Trailable Yacht and Sports Boats Rules , ATYSBR National CBH list July, 2019 and the rules of the Trailable Yacht classes. (except if any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and excluding ATYSBR Appendix : 'the following symbols (FBM) Fully Battened Main and (SKF) Swing Keel Flaps, identify performance improvements that are becoming common place and may not be permitted within either the class rules or the designer's specifications.'

Alternatively (and at the discretion of the Handicapper) - Australian Class Based Handicap (CBH) Rating system for Trailable Yachts and Sport boats July 2022 may be used in place of or additional to compilation of results for the term of this regatta.

The Regatta will be held as a PHS event, a CBH prize may be awarded based on the above at the discretion of the Regatta Committee.

Any correction to CBH based on the definitions above may not be taken into account for the purposes of the Regatta.

All yachts shall display sail numbers. Auxiliary engines must be fitted on their operating brackets whilst racing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to boats complying with the Australian Trailable Yacht and Sports Boats rule (exception as above in Rule 1) and all other boats accepted by the Committee of the Organising Authority. Eligible boats may enter on the attached entry form accompanied by the required fee. Beach entries will be accepted.

2. Schedule of Events.

Events are scheduled in the regatta as follows:

Registration will be at Race Headquarters or with the committee boat from 900 hours Saturday, February 3 to 1150 hours. (9.00 hours to 9.50 hours for Sunday only competitors).

Race 1 - Warning Signal time not before 1255 hours Saturday, February 3

Race 2 - Warning Signal time not before 1055 hours Sunday, February 4

3. Measurements

Random measurements may be carried out during the regatta.

4. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions for the regatta will be available from race headquarters from 9.00 hours Saturday, February 3 after registration has been completed and may also be available on the SIBYC website

5. Racing Area & Courses

Races will be conducted on St Georges Basin, courses will be described in the sailing instructions and at the briefing.

6. Scoring

The Low Point scoring system WS RRS 90.3 (and A4) will apply except that there will be two races. A minimum of 1 race is required to constitute a series. Each boat's score will be the total of her race scores. All scores shall be counted.

7. Radio Communication

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This also applies to mobile telephones.

8. Prizes

1st and 2nd prizes will be awarded to the winning boats of each division in the two-race regatta based on PHS corrected times, a CBH Overall prize may be presented.

Daily prizes may be awarded.

Island Point ramp, Island Point Rd

Basin View ramp, Basin View Rd is the regional launching ramp and is more suitable for boats requiring a greater depth of water to launch.

Chris Creek ramp, River Rd, Sussex Inlet - just north of Chris Creek bridge
